

## WEST HENDERSON HIGH SCHOOL ELECTRONIC DEVICE EXPECTATIONS For Students



Rationale: Our vision is to be the standard of academic, extracurricular, and civic excellence. We strive to be the best high school in the state, and we communicate that in part by protecting the learning environment and maintaining a safe school. Below you will find a guideline for electronic device use.

Electronic devices are defined as cell phones, iPods, tablets, speakers, headsets, or earbuds. Students are not allowed to use electronic devices between the hours of 8 a.m. and 3 p.m. except during class changes, lunch, or teacher-led classroom activities. Individual speakers are not allowed at any time on campus.

At any time during classroom use, the teacher reserves the right to allow, disallow, or monitor the use of electronic devices.

**Consequences:** On the first offense, students will receive a verbal warning. If a second offense occurs, the teacher will assign the student a detention. Subsequent offenses may result in In-School Suspension.
