Convene an Annual Meeting

Traditionally, Atkinson Elementary hosts an open house event in September. During open house, Atkinson presents information about Title I funding and programs. Due to health and safety during the pandemic, we did not host this event this year. However, a video with Title I funding and programs will be sent out to parents and families this fall. On September 1, 2021, parents and families were sent a notification letter about Atkinson's Title I program which is also available on our school's website. Dependent on if we can safely host a first quarter PTO meeting, Atkinson Elementary will conduct a family input, question, and answer session about our Title I Program.

Offer a Flexible Parent and Family Engagement Educational and Informational

Activities

While we will have to be creative during the pandemic, Atkinson Elementary will provide educational and informational activities and opportunities for families throughout the school year. These include, but are not limited to, academic engagement activities, information about student assessments, which will detail proficiency levels and expected student growth, and strategies families can use to help students succeed. Feedback from families will assist Atkinson in different engagement activities to offer. Virtual events and/or recordings will be held and available at varying times to accommodate the needs of working families.

Involve Parents and Families in an Organized, Ongoing, and Timely Way

Atkinson Elementary will provide parent representation on the School Improvement Team, the PTO board, and Superintendent's Parent Advisory Council. Parents and families will be included in decisions involving The School Improvement Plan, this Parent and Family Engagement Policy, and will be asked to serve on various school committees.

Provide Timely Information

Individual teacher conferences will be scheduled at times convenient for families, as well as MTSS (Multi-Tiered System of Supports) meetings, 504 meetings, and IEP (Individualized Education Program) placement meetings. Teacher newsletters, websites, social media, educational apps, report cards, progress reports, and standardized test results will all be used to keep families informed about school events and their child's educational needs and progress.

Provide for Family Comments

Atkinson Elementary will provide opportunities for family comments on the schoolwide plan through conferences, committees, the School Improvement Team, and surveys.

Atkinson Elementary recognizes the importance of home and school communication, involvement, and collaboration for the success and well-being of our students and encourages parents to communicate regularly with faculty and staff.
