Students have the opportunity to earn one or more of the following diploma endorsements identifying a particular area of focused study:

- 2. College Endorsement (two options)
- 3. North Carolina Academic Scholars Endorsement
- 4. Global Languages Endorsement

No endorsement is required to receive a diploma.
