

Course Registration for 2021-2022

The course registration process is online through each student's PowerSchool account. All students must choose 8 courses (or courses equaling 8.0 credits) and 3 alternate courses for next year. **All students must enter their course requests online from February 24-February 26.** *Class Registration in PowerSchool will open at 12:00 pm on Thursday, February 24.

- Prior to registration opening in Powerschool, please check to make sure you can log into your student PowerSchool account. If you are unable to login, please contact one of your teachers and ask him/her to reset your password. If you are new to NHHS, you may need to claim your account before being able to log in.
- The Registration Worksheet, Course Descriptions, Grade Level Screencasts, and other documents referred to below are linked in the Student Files (parents will need to log in with their students' email address to access Student Files). Students can also find this information in grade-level Google Classrooms. In addition, all registration materials were sent to students/parents/guardians via email.

Course Selection Decisions: We encourage all families to talk with their students about their course requests and choose the classes together. For the list of available courses for the 2021-2022 school year, please view the Registration Worksheet and Important Information Document. Courses highlighted in blue are live links that will take you to videos NHHS teachers made to describe their course in more detail. Virtual Live Teacher Q & A Sessions on February 24- Teachers, Counselors, and Administrators will host virtual Q&A sessions. The times and Google Meet links for these sessions are posted on the Live Q&A Sessions for Registration Document. **Students will log into classes at the regularly scheduled time for attendance and a 10 min check-in before they are dismissed to attend their chosen Q&A session.** Students should choose four sessions to attend, one for each period/time slot.

How do you choose which session to attend? Ask yourself, "What do I still have questions about? Am I deciding between two electives? Am I trying to select alternates? or Am I thinking about taking an Honors, AP, or CCP course? etc." To summarize...You should select the 4 sessions that will help you determine/guide your course selections for the 2021-2022 school year.

Courses That Require An Application: If you are interested in [Yearbook](#); [BRCC courses](#), (11and 12th only), or [CTE Internship](#) (12th only), you must submit an application(s) by February 26.

Select 3 Alternate Course Selections: Please note the importance of the 3 alternate courses. We first look at scheduling your 8 primary requests but because of scheduling conflicts and/or class size limits, students will frequently be placed in one or more of their alternate courses. **IMPORTANT: When selecting your alternate choices do not duplicate any of your primary choices (duplicated selections are omitted by PowerSchool).**

February 24-February 26 is the window to enter your 8 course requests and 3 alternates into PowerSchool. If you do not enter your course request during the registration window, counselors will make **two attempts** to contact you. If those attempts are unsuccessful, counselors will select your 2021-2022 courses for you.
