## Freshman Course Registration for 2021-2022

The course registration process is online through each student's PowerSchool account. *Students are pre-registered for required freshman classes. Student placement is based on recommendations provided by their 8th grade ELA, Math, Science, and Social Studies teachers. If the parent/guardian disagrees with the teacher's recommendation and would like an alternative placement, please complete this [Google Form](#).* All students must enter their course requests online from **March 30-April 2**.

- Prior to registration opening in Powerschool, please check to make certain you can log into your student PowerSchool account. If you are unable to login, please contact one of your teachers and ask him/her to reset your password. If you are new to NHHS, you may need to claim your account before being able to log in.

**Course Selection Decisions:** We encourage all families to talk with their students about their course requests and choose the classes together. **Courses That Require An Application:** If you are interested in [Yearbook](#) you must submit an application by April 2.

**Select 3 Alternate Course Selections:** Please note the importance of the 3 alternate courses. We first look at scheduling your 3 first choice elective requests but because of scheduling conflicts and/or class size limits, students will frequently be placed in one or more of their alternate courses.

**IMPORTANT: When selecting your alternate choices do not duplicate any of your primary choices (duplicated selections are thrown out by PowerSchool).**

**March 30-April 2** is the window to enter your 3 elective course requests and 3 alternate requests into PowerSchool. If you do not enter your course request during the registration window, counselors will make **two attempts** to contact you. If those attempts are unsuccessful, counselors will select your 2021-2022 courses for you.
