The Henderson County Public Schools' Student Code of Conduct and Annual Notifications contains the behavior expectations for our students as well as required annual notifications regarding: Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), Protection of Pupil Rights Amendment (PPRA), Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964; TITLE IX of the Education Amendments of 1972; The Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (Section 504) and The Americans With Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA), Students with Disabilities – Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA), Homeless Students – McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act, Student Health Issues, Student Restraint/Seclusion/Isolation, Use of Pesticides: N.C.G.S. 115C-47(47), Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA), Title I Parental Involvement, Free or Reduced School Lunch Information, NCLB/FERPA Opt-Out Letter, and Acceptable Use of Internet and Computer Resources.
