

NOTICE OF SPECIAL CALLED MEETING

Return to Learn Recommendation

March 12, 2021

The Henderson County Board of Public Education will hold a Special Called meeting on Friday, March 12, 2021, beginning at 10:00am, in the Boardroom of the Administrative Offices located at 414 Fourth Avenue West in Hendersonville, North Carolina.

The primary reason for the meeting will be to discuss an updated Return to Learn Plan recommendation with regard to newly proposed legislation from Governor Roy Cooper.

This meeting will be held in accordance with approved, safety thresholds for public gatherings established by our local health officials and the Governor. Capacity for the public/staff is capped at no more than 25 persons. Therefore, limited members of the public will be allowed into the meeting room. The Board will receive public comment, subject to time limitations set by the Board, pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 115C-51, during this meeting and through pre-submitted emails received for this purpose. - *must contain the name and address of sender
- *must be received no later than 9:00am on Friday, March 12, 2020
- *should be limited to 3 minutes in length when read aloud
