

NOTICE OF SPECIAL CALLED MEETING

Return to Learn Recommendation

August 2, 2021

The Henderson County Board of Public Education will hold a Special Called meeting on Monday, August 2, 2021, beginning at 9:00am, in the Boardroom of the Administrative Offices located at 414 Fourth Avenue West in Hendersonville, North Carolina.

The primary reason for the meeting will be to discuss the *Return to Learn* plan recommendation with regard to the recently updated StrongSchoolsNC Public Health Toolkit, which goes into effect on July 30, 2021.

The Board will receive public comment during the meeting subject to a 30 minute total time limit set by Board policy, pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 115C-51. In order to accommodate more speakers, the Board may reduce the time for each speaker below the current 3 minute maximum and/or request that groups representing the same viewpoint select a spokesperson.
