## Quarantine Guidance – Schools

#### A STUDENT OR STAFF MEMBER HAS BEEN DETERMINED TO BE A CLOSE CONTACT WITH SOMEONE DIAGNOSED WITH COVID-19 IN THE PAST 14 DAYS

2. Sore throat

4. Diarrhea or vomiting

#### Does the individual have symptoms of COVID-19?

- 1. Fever (temperature of 100.4 °F or higher)
- 3. New loss of taste or smell
- 5. New onset of severe headache, especially with fever
- 6. Cough (for people with chronic cough due to allergies or asthma, a change in cough from baseline)
- 7. Difficulty breathing (for people with asthma, a change from their baseline breathing)


#### Does the individual meet any of the following 3 conditions?

- 1. Individual is fully vaccinated and does not have symptoms.
- 2. Individual has tested positive for COVID-19 within the past 3 months and has recovered and does not have symptoms.
- 3. Individual is an unvaccinated student with a close contact in a school setting where face coverings were being worn appropriately and consistently by both the person with COVID-19 and the close contact.

#### No guarantine is required.\*

Close contacts under these conditions do NOT need to quarantine. It is recommended that fully vaccinated individuals without symptoms (1<sup>st</sup> condition) get tested on the 5<sup>th</sup> day after they had close contact and wear a face covering around others until receiving a negative test result.

Quarantine for 10 days.\* If the individual declines to test for COVID-19, he or she may return to school on **Day** 

still asymptomatic.

**11** (the day after completing the full 10 days of quarantine) if they are still asymptomatic.

#### Quarantine for 7 days.\*

The individual may test for COVID-19 on or after the 5<sup>th</sup> day after they had close contact with someone with COVID-19 (not before).

If this person has a negative test result AND is asymptomatic, he or she may return to school on Day 8 (the day after completing the full 7 days of guarantine).

Shortened quarantine guidance for school settings (less than 14 days) is based on the universal face covering requirement currently in place.
